Companionship Responsibilities

Basic Function:

To provide professional companionship services to clients according to HIHC policies.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Companionship & Conversation
- Arrange & Remind for Appointments
- Medication Reminders and Observation
- Meal Planning, Preparation & Clean-up
- Plan and Assist with Entertainment
- Answer the Telephone & Door Dressing Assistance
- Provide Safety Assurance
- Participate in Crafts and Games
- Supervise Home Maintenance
- Oversee Home Deliveries
- Maintain Client Calendar
- Provide a Stable Bathing Environment

Home Helper Responsibilities

Basic Function

To provide professional housekeeping services to clients according to HIHC policies.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Meal Preparation & Grocery Shopping
- Light Housekeeping
- Laundry & Ironing, Pick-up/Deliver Dry Cleaning
- Take Out Garbage
- Make Beds and Change Linens

- Pick Up Prescriptions
- Escort to Appointments & Events
- Assist with Pet Care
- Organize & Clean Closets
- Dust Furniture
- Care of Houseplants



Home Care Services

Overnight Responsibilities

To provide professional companionship services to clients according to HIHC policies.

Primary Responsibilities

- All primary responsibilities of a companionship (See Companionship description)
- Assisting clients to bed
- Assisting clients throughout the night and recording the number of times assistance is needed
- Preparation of morning meal and cleanup of meal related items

Secondary Responsibilities: The responsibilities for the above position descriptions include:

- 1. Contribute to a positive living environment for the overall quality of life for the client.
- 2. Perform other reasonable, related duties as assigned or requested per the Care Plan.
- 3. Reporting any significant changes in the clients' needs or living conditions.

<u>Essential Qualifications:</u> (Include minimum education, experience and specific skills required to perform Primary Responsibilities.)

- 1. Speaking and hearing English clearly in person and on the telephone.
- 2. Reading and writing English on an average adult level.
- 4. Ability to treat and care for clients and their property with dignity and respect.
- 5. Ability to communicate with the client in a friendly and congenial manner.
- Ability to communicate with office staff to ensure that service expectations are met.

Special Requirements:

- 1. Ability to adapt to various individual living environments and locations.
- 2. Ability to lift 25 lbs., bending, twisting, kneeling, reaching, pushing, pulling and carrying.
- 3. Ability to withstand periodic contact with dog/cat hair, dust, mold, mildew and cleaning solutions.
